Maharashtra Energy Development Agency (MEDA) (hereinafter called "MEDA") is implementing Pradhan Mantri Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyaan (PM-KUSUM) Scheme of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Govt. of India. The scheme proposes to implement 17.50 Lakhs of standalone Solar Powered Agriculture Pumps of individual pump capacity up to 7.5 HP and 10 Lakhs grid connected Solar Powered Agriculture Pumps of individual pump capacity up to 7.5 HP. Under this scheme MEDA has received the allocation for installation of 1,00,000 Numbers of solar pumps for the farmers located in Maharashtra. This scheme is being implemented within the period between FY 2020-21 to 21-22.

 Considering the large volume and distributed installation of solar water pumps across Maharashtra, MEDA is looking forward to get assistance from third party agencies to support its activities related to 1) Solar Pump Site Feasibility including verification of documents received through online application, 2) Inspection/Verification of installed Solar Water Pumping Sets at the sanctioned beneficiary farm location. 3) MNRE standard testing of solar pumps for water output, all parameter testing 1 No. out of 10000 No. or at least 1No.of each of vender. 2. BRIEF INFORMATION OF PROJECT AND ACTIVITIES

Maharashtra Energy Development Agency (MEDA) (hereinafter called "MEDA") is implementing Pradhan Mantri Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyaan (PM-KUSUM) Scheme of Ministry of New and Renewable Energy, Govt. of India. The scheme proposes to implement 17.50 Lakhs of standalone Off Grid Solar Powered Agriculture Pumps of individual pump capacity 3HP to 7.5 HP. Under this scheme MEDA has received the allocation for installation of 1,00,000 Numbers of solar pumps for the farmers located in Maharashtra. This scheme is being implemented within the period between FY 2020-21 to 21-22.

The Revenue Division-wise / Region-wise sub distribution of allocation in first phase within Maharashtra is as follows:

The allocation of target as above is tentative and will vary based on the farmer's response to the application of Solar Pump Scheme.

Considering the 1.00 Lakhs pumps installation within Maharashtra over a short period MEDA intends to appoint third party Technical surveyors to assist MEDA in

- 1) Survey for Solar Pump Site Feasibility including verification of documents received through online/offline applications
- 2) Inspection/Verification of installed Solar Water Pumping Sets at the sanctioned beneficiary farm location.
- 3) MNRE standard testing of solar pumps for water output, all parameter testing 1 No. out of 10000 No. or at least 1No.of each of vender or at least one no. in each district.

Hence, MEDA is hereby inviting Expression of Interest from Third Party Surveyors, Consultants, Academic Institutions, NGOs, Engineering Colleges, Agriculture Colleges, KVKs. Universities etc. The selection of agencies for Third Party Surveyors shall be selected for specific districts / regions based on their strength to execute the assignment and / or depending on their geographical presence to execute the activities. The techno-commercial requirements from the Third-Party surveyors are given separately in this bid document. Out of the total five regions / Six Revenue Division in Maharashtra, the agencies are free to apply for a particular division, for specific regions or all the regions based on their strength, geographical presence so as to make a competitive bid for completion of stated work.

3. SCOPE OF WORK FOR SURVEYOR'S

For undertaking the work of third-party field survey and Technical Inspection/verification of installation bids from the Third-Party Surveyors, Consultants, Academic Institutions, NGOs, Engineering Colleges, Agriculture Colleges, KVKs, Universities etc. are being called. The activities are broadly as follows:

1) Survey for Solar Pump Site Feasibility including verification of documents received through online application,

- The Agencies are required to undertake field survey based on the application received from the farmers. MEDA shall be sharing the detailed online/ offline application forms received from the end beneficiaries to the surveyors.
- Agencies need to verify the documents submitted online and undertake field survey original to be verify, for adhhar OTP verification MEDA will provide approval from govt Authority / original letter to be taken for verification from concern Authority and for verification 7/12 surveyer should provide online copy from land record department in case or original confirmation letter from Talathi.
- Agencies shall be provided a survey form for collecting the information. Also, criteria set for short listing of the beneficiaries will be provided. Agencies shall duly fill the survey forms and recommend the feasible or non feasible of beneficiary.
- MEDA shall provide training to the successful bidders for operating the online portal for submission of survey forms. Also the Project implementation methodology shall be given to the successful bidder. This will enable the successful bidder to complete the survey reporting on the web-portal. The
- Surveyor shall upload the survey forms within week time from completion of the survey. Along with site selfie/photograph with date, time and location detail as per requirement along with farmer and vender The Surveyor shall carry smart mobile so as to collect the site photographs along with geo co-ordinates (lat/long) of the location proposed for installation of solar pump. (in the develop app by MEDA)
- Agencies shall be responsible for providing correct and true information to MEDA.
- This activity shall be completed by the Agency within a time span of Two months from the sharing the details of the beneficiaries for survey.

2) Technical Inspection/Verification of installed Solar Water Pumping Sets at the sanctioned beneficiary location.

- On completion of installation of solar pumps, agencies shall be communicated to undertake verification of installation of solar water pumping set.
- MEDA shall be providing the format for verification of technical details of the pump installed.
- Agencies shall verify the details and submit the duly filled forms to MEDA on completion of verification of installation.
- Agency shall provide photographs and video of installation as per predefine norms and standards.
- This activity shall be completed by the Agency within a time span of Two Months from the time of installation of solar pumps as communicated by the developers/suppliers/MEDA/beneficiary depending on the project implementation methodology shared at later stage.
- Shall provide all serial number along with photo, for pump and motor shall provide undertaking from supplier & confirmation type of structure (Fixed, signal axis, dual axis)
- Verification of insurance document as per site detail like serial number , name , address, tenure if any
- MEDA shall conduct the re-verification for 25% capacity which already inspected by concern selected bidder.
- At the time of MEDA re-verification any kind of ambiguity found in provided reports by selected bidder and actual site condition, in such case selected bidder will be out rightly blacklisted and SD shall be forfeited of selected bidder.
- This work is for 100000 pumps (Site Feasibility and Technical Inspection / Verification). However MEDA reserved the right to place work order for limited number of pumps.
- 3) MNRE standard testing of solar pumps for water output, all parameter testing 1 No. out of 10000 No. or at least 1No.of each of vender or at least one no. in each district.
 - Shall provide field performance test report for 1 pump in 10000 pump as per MNRE guidelines for water output test in presence of MEDA official along with full day HD Video Recording.
 - Selected bidder shall carry out standard testing of solar water pumping systems for water out & all parameter testing 1 no. out of 10000 no. or at least 1 no. in each district or 1 no. of each vendor.
 - For this work concerned solar pump installer will provide all instruments for carrying out the water output & all parameter testing surveyor agency

along with MEDA officials and solar pump bidder will attend the testing activities and submit the test reports. If testing reports qualify with MNRE test report, then MEDA can permit to start the work of pump installation or Director General, MEDA reserve rights to accept or reject the pump testing activities of pump vendor after verifying MNRE accredited laboratory report of the concerned vendor.

4. BIDDER QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

Agencies like Third Party Surveyors, Consultants, Academic Institutions, NGOs, Engineering Colleges, Agriculture Colleges, KVKs, Universities etc. can participate in the bid provided they meet the set technical and commercial qualification criteria.

Technical Qualification Criteria:

- The Agency shall have valid registration certificate for registration under Companies Act 1956/2013 or Society Act or Bombay Public Trusts Act, or Registered Partnership Firms or Limited Liability Partnership Firms or Proprietary Firms etc.
- 2) The agency shall have mandatory office in the Maharashtra.
- 3) The Agency shall have competent and sufficient manpower for execution of the proposed scope of work. The Manpower should be Engineering Graduates, Diploma Holder Engineers, ITI Technicians with Surya Mitra Certifications or Agriculture Professionals undergone Solar Trainings or experience in this field.
- CV of minimum TEN surveyors per district shall be submitted in Technical BID Document. Mandatory to have good communication skill in Marathi and Hindi (optional).
- 5) Bidders should demonstrate their experience in conducting survey for Govt. / Private agencies on a large scale (covering the sample size of more than 1000 numbers in Maharashtra or 2000 pan India, should be distributed region wise for quantity) for pvt bidder.
- 6) Bidder can bid in their district or immediate connected district only, to be verified by GST certificate
- 7) JV between multiple institutes for better coverage will be accepted under single bid.
- Bidder should have in-house team of Technical background at list 5 person (Renewable energy) along with at list one person with 10 year of expectance in solar field
- 9) For local presence should provide GST registration copy belong to bidding area
- 10) Shall submit proof of pump test require equipment list along with calibration certificate for MNRE standard test

Financial Qualification Criteria

JV BID -

- 1. JV under single lead bidder, JV is permitted area wise for Example A as Lead bidder can have JV with B bidder for Marathwada, JV with C bidder for Konkan and bid will be submitted under A in JV with B & C for Marathwada and Konkan
- 2. Lead Bidder will be solely responsible for the contract.
- 3. Hon. DG MEDA may relax Technical or financial experience criteria for Government Institution / Gov. Undertaking /Universities.

5. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BID submission and selection criteria

- The technical BID along with supporting documents shall be uploaded online on the bidding portal within the due date and time provided. Hard Copy of the BID document is not required. The Financial BID shall be submitted online.
- The Fees towards tender fee and EMD shall be submitted online. EMD in the form of

Bank Guarantee is not permitted.

- The conditional bids / bids without supporting documents in support of technical and financial qualification shall be out rightly rejected.
- Bidders are requested to understand the scope of work completely before submission of the BID. Bidders can apply for multiple regions / districts for undertaking the work based on the strength of their team members.
- The financial bid shall be submitted in the prescribed format. The bidder shall quote for single sample survey and verification. All the out of pocket expenses like travel, communication, printing etc. shall be considered by bidder while submitting the financial BID. MEDA shall not provide any additional cost over and above the quoted price in the BID.
- Financial BID of technically qualified bidders will be opened on the date and time mentioned.
- Region wise / district wise L1 bidder shall be selected for award of work.
- MEDA reserves the right to award the bid to multiple Agencies so as to ensure smooth and efficient completion of work in each region/district if the bidders are agrees to match L1 BIDs.
- Selected bidder shall provide the Mobile No. which shall be pre-approved by MEDA.
- For the allotted work selected bidder shall make Lodging, Boarding, transport provision for survey and inspection by their own cost .

Team Proposed for Undertaking Survey

The bidder shall submit the details of team proposed to undertake the scope of work. Single point contact person shall be specified as project co-ordinator for liasoning with MEDA. Detailed CV of proposed team of surveyors shall be submitted as part of technical BID document. In case the Agency wants to add additional manpower or replace the existing team member during execution of the assignment, they shall get their CV approved before deputing for execution of the assignment. Survey carried by unapproved team member shall not be accepted. The team member executing shall carry the smart phones for taking site photographs, checking the orientation of solar panels, taking co-ordinates of the location where solar pump is being installed.

Survey Data

The Agency shall be responsible for verifying and interpretation of all data provided by the concern beneficiary. MEDA shall have no responsibility for the accuracy, sufficiency or completeness of data. The collected data shall be submitted to MEDA and the Agency shall not use any of the information collected or shall not share any information to any third party.

Information generated out of this activity is proprietary of MEDA, selected bidder have to enter in Non Disclosure Agreement (NDA) & Privacy agreement with MEDA.

Responsibilities of the Bidder / Agency

- Bidder/Shortlisted agency shall take care of all reasonable steps to protect the environment, rules and regulations applicable while execution of the work.
- Bidder shall be responsible for ensuring the correctness of information being submitted to MEDA. In any case if the agency or its surveyors are found in undertaking fraudulent practices, then MEDA shall immediately terminate the contract of the Agency and will blacklist such agency. The pending work or the uncompleted work of that Agency will be transferred to the other bidders / agencies. In such cases the retention amount of the Agency along with the security deposit shall be forfeited by MEDA. The Agency will be held responsible for the fraudulent practices carried by its employees / surveyors etc.
- The technical staff employed by the agency shall be provided required knowledge by the Agency.
- Agency shall ensure safety of its staff while execution of the assignment. The Own- and Third-Party risk and liability shall be completely with Agency shortlisted for the execution of this proposed work.

Price Variation, Taxes, Duties & Levies etc.

The price quoted by the bidder shall remain valid for 180 days from the date of opening of the technical bid. The bidder shall take care of the variations in prices/taxes/duties/levies of the materials, labors, supplies etc and quote the price appropriately. Once the prices are fixed then in any case MEDA will not allow any variation in remuneration for the proposed scope.

Terms of Payment

The payment of fees shall be as per the price quoted for the two broad activities as follows:

A) Survey for Solar Pump Site Feasibility

• 80% of the survey cost shall be paid through monthly running bills submitted on completion of survey and on submission of required information.

- 10% of the survey cost shall be paid on acceptance of complete survey allotted to Agency.
- 10% of the Survey cost shall be paid after 6 months of completion of the assignment.

B) Verification of Installed Solar Pump

- 80% of the field verification cost shall be paid through monthly running bills submitted on completion of field verification and on submission of required information.
- 10% of the field verification cost shall be paid on acceptance of complete field verification allotted to Agency and 1 no out of 1000 no field performance test report as per MNRE water output.
- 10% of the field verification cost shall be paid after 6 months of completion of the assignment.

Deduction:-

- The TDS at the source will be deducted as per the Govt. Rule and regulations.
- MEDA will issue necessary certificates of TDS deduction.
- Security Deposit:- Selected Agency has to pay 3 % amount of total work order cost amount as a Security Deposit to MEDA within 7 days after placement of work order.

Penalty / Liquidity Damages

If the Agency is not able to complete the allotted work within the stipulated period as mentioned in the work order the Bidder shall be required to pay penalty of 1/2% (half percent) per week, maximum up to 10% of the non-completed work. The said amount shall be deducted from the payment being made to Agency by MEDA.

If the Successful bidder /agency is not able to complete the allotted work in due time, the same shall be get done through other Agency and the Successful bidder will have to bear all the cost incurred against the balance work left by him. If Agency fails to execute the work, then MEDA will forfeit bidders SD & EMD amount.

Right to withdraw the BID and to reject any BID

Director General MEDA reserves all rights to accept, cancel the bid at any time without assigning any reasons thereof. Director General MEDA reserves all rights to reject any or all bidders or change the conditions mentioned in the bid documents at any stage or take any decision regarding implementation of this bid without assigning any reasons whatsoever. MEDA reserve the right to interpret the Bid submitted by the Bidder in accordance with the provisions of the BID and make its own judgment regarding the interpretation of the same. In this regard the MEDA shall have no liability towards any Bidder and no Bidder shall have any recourse to the MEDA with respect to the selection process. MEDA decision in this regard shall be final and binding on the Bidders.

Risk and Responsibility

The Agency shall indemnify and hold harmless the MEDA / beneficiary and its personnel, against and from all claims, damages, losses and expenses (including legal fees and expenses) in respect of:

A. Bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, of any person whatsoever arising out of or in the course of or by reason of the design, execution and completion of the Works and the remedying of any defects, unless attributable to any negligence, willful act or breach of the Contract by the MEDA, or any of their respective agents, and Damage to or loss of any property, real or personal (other than the Works), to the extent that such damage or loss:

B. Is not attributable to any negligence, fulfill act or breach of Contract by the MEDA or its personnel, their respective agents, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them.

Insurance

The Agency shall will ensure that all its employees and representatives are covered by suitable insurance against any damage, loss, injury or death arising out of the execution of the work or in carrying out the Contract. Liquidation, Death, Bankruptcy etc., shall be the responsibility of Agency.

The Agency shall take up the matter with insurance company on its own for finalization of claims. All actions in connection with making and settling of claims, if any, will be carried out by the bidder at its own. MEDA shall not be liable for any payments for financial loss or non-recovery of payment from the insurance company.

Liability for Accidents and Damage

The Agency shall be responsible for any loss / damage to its staff while execution of the assignment. The Agency shall be responsible for any such loss and damage.

In case of negligence of the employees / surveyors of the Agency, if there is subsequent damage or loss to third party or to the beneficiary or to MEDA, the Agency shall be sole responsible for resolution of such damages.

The Agency shall indemnify and keep the MEDA harmless against all actions, suits, claims, costs, or expenses arising in connection with injuries other than such as may be attributable to the agency or his employees.

Disputes and its Resolution

Dispute (s), if any, shall be settled by mutual agreement through Amicable Settlement. The Responsible officer from MEDA shall try to resolve all the resolve disputes arising while execution of the assignment. In case, the Agency is not agreeing to the dispute resolution proposed by the responsible officer of MEDA, the said disputes will be presented before Director General MEDA for Amicable Settlement. The decision of Director General MEDA shall be final and binding to both the parties.
